Sample Resolution in Support of Continued and Increased State Aid for Local Governments

Whereas, until 2024, cities, villages and towns had not received an increase in unrestricted state aid (AIM funding) in 15 years, significantly impacting their ability to provide essential services to their residents; and

Whereas, after a prolonged period without financial support, local governments finally received an increase of \$50 million in unrestricted state aid; and

Whereas, local officials express their gratitude for the \$50 million increase in unrestricted state aid, recognizing it as a positive step towards addressing long-standing funding challenges; and

Whereas, the State has referred to this new aid as Temporary Municipal Assistance, suggesting that such increase may not continue, jeopardizing the sustainability of crucial municipal programs and services; and

Whereas, the property tax cap further limits the ability of local governments to properly fund the programs and services their residents need; and

Whereas, increased and ongoing state aid for local governments is vital for maintaining infrastructure, public safety, housing and other municipal services; and

Whereas, the challenges of inflation, the increasing costs of labor and supplies, and the end of extraordinary federal aid only accentuate the need for consistent and predictable funding to effectively plan for the future and meet the growing needs of their residents;

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the village of Flower Hill calls upon the Governor and the State Legislature to commit to continuing the additional \$50 million in unrestricted state aid in the 2025-26 State Budget and beyond, and

Be it further resolved, that [Your Municipality] urges state officials to recognize the need for a long-term plan that ensures consistent and predictable increases in financial support for local governments that keep pace with inflation.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INC. VILLLAGE OF FLOWER HILL

Pursuant to Section 227-17 of the Village Code entitled "Parking prohibited certain hours".

WHEREAS, section 227-17 and schedule XII of section 227-36 of the Village Code allow the Board to establish and amend no parking requirements upon Sunnyvale Drive between November 25 and January 10 between the hours of 6:00 PM and 11:00 PM, and

WHEREAS, the Board had become aware that an installation on Sunnyvale Road under the definition of Exhibition Lighting found at section 114-3.1 of the Village Code may be in place within the time period described above, and

WHEREAS, in the past, when such exhibitions have been installed the Board has found that no parking restrictions during the time of such an exhibition along Sunnyvale Road have been consistent with the protection of the residents of the Village, and

WHEREAS, although the Board has since been provided information that any installation at the location may not be in the form requiring a permit, but the Board nonetheless wishes to insure that safety is maintained along the road,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That parking shall be prohibited on both sides of Sunnyvale Road on such days within the time period identified above and at such hours as shall be determined by the Mayor or such Code Enforcement Official as he may designate between until January 10, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

That appropriate signage is to be installed along Sunnyvale Road consistent with the designation of prohibited parking.
